educational experience. We dine in the café amongst the Autumn Blaze Maple trees. Our afternoon visit is to the Yarra Valley Chocolateries and Ice Creamery. We'll be welcomed with chocolate tastings, displays of thousands of premium chocolates and European Chocolatiers at work handcrafting their creations. Our final venue is the family owned, Rochford Wines. Situated in one of the most stunning regions in Australia, with breathtaking panoramic views of the Great Dividing Ranges we relax over a delightful tasting.
