Largely unknown, Arkaroola is one of Australia's true tourism gems. Next is Leigh Creek in the Far North where we will spend 2 nights with a sightseeing flight to see the "Marree Man" (the world's largest work of art and one of Australia's greatest "who-done-it" mysteries in recent times) and Lake Eyre South. In Port Augusta, at the head of the Spencer Gulf, we will be introduced to the Far North region at the Wadlata Outback Centre

Itinerary Details

Day 1 (D): Arrive Adelaide

Friday 18 October



Welcome to our extended South Australian Tour featuring the *Flinders/Gammon Ranges* in the Far North and Leigh Creek (with Outback sightseeing flights over Lake Eyre. Our flight this morning will have us into *Adelaide* by early

afternoon. (QANT AS Flight 2161/733 Departs Port Macquarie at 6.30am/Arrives Adelaide at 10.20am). Our **Port Bus** touring coach will meet us. From Adelaide Airport we head north to **Port Pirie** for our first night on tour.

Day 2 (BLD): To the Flinders Ranges

We then head further north this morning. We travel through the *Pichi Richi Pass* and cross the famed *Goyder's Line* that was marked on the map in 1865 by Surveyor General George Woodroffe Goyder to delineate drought affected

country. The line became an important factor in settlement planning in this State, being regarded as an indication of the limits of the lands



considered safe for agricultural development. As we will see from the many ruins on the *Wilochra Plain*, many early settlers didn't take Goyder's advice! An excellent example is *Kanyaka Homestead*

just south of Hawker. We stop at the Wilpena Pound Information Centre before continuing into the *Gammon Ranges National Park*, in the Northern Flinders - one of Australia's true tourism gems.

Arkaroola Wilderness Sanctuary is blessed with a unique landscape

created over 2 billion years ago and is home to the most rugged chain of mountains in the Australia n Outback. At night there is a chance to visit Australia's largest privately owned *Astronomical Observatory*.



Day 2 (BLD): To the Flinders Ranges Saturday 19 October



Tours of the Universe from this facility and the "star chairs" provide a unique experience for the traveller that is normally only available to scientists and astronomers (entry own cost/depends on local weather conditions).

Day 3 (BLD): Ridge Top Tour

This morning, we take the incredible 4WD 'Ridge Top Tour' driving along mine tracks winding through some of Australia's most rugged mountains. Visit 'Crystal Candy Mountain', Mt Painter, Yudanamutana Gorge and Sillers Lookout with awe inspiring views extending more

than 80 kms over Lake Frome. We return to Arkaroola for lunch and then the afternoon is free to enjoy the area. Take a self-guided walk or perhaps just kick back and relax. Meal inclusions: Breakfast lunch & dinner at accommodation

Day 4 (BLD): Leigh Creek

This morning, we travel west to Leigh Creek. This will be our base for two nights. Our sightseeing flight from here tomorrow over **Lake Eyre South** and the **Marree Man** will be a highlight of our tour.

Just to the north of here is Lake Eyre. The sheer magnitude of the *Kati* **Thanda-Lake Eyre Region** is breathtaking. Our flight crosses over the

up through to the Southern tip of Kati Thanda-Lake Eyre North and Belt Bay, the lowest point on mainland Australia. From here we pass Silcrete Island and Dalhunty Island. After following the Warburton Groove



north, we now track east to the Cooper Creek Inlet then down through Madigan Bay. The myriad of colours emblazoned in patterns of ochre and pink algae create an amazing kaleidoscope of colour. With water, the reflections are breathtaking. **Wrights Air** who has experienced,



professional pilots with extensive knowledge of the South Australian Outback region will provide us with a stunning sightseeing flight. Using their quality, high wing aircraft everyone gets a window seat. It will be a wonderful experience

Day 6 (BLD): Heading South

This morning, we head south back to *Hawker* and then through to *Port Augusta* at the top of the Spencer Gulf. There is a wonderful outback interpretative centre here called the *Wadlata* which provides a great introduction to visitors to the remote

north and northw est of South Australia. We have a look through the Centre. Our overnight accommodation tonight is in *Port Pirie*.

Day 7 (BLD): Burra & Mid North

Thursday 24 October



We travel through *Crystal Brook* this morning and then onto *Burra*. It was here in Burra, in 1845, that copper was discovered. Very quickly a town developed with a community of 5000 in 1851 (Adelaide's population was 18 000 at that time). Today the whole town is on

the State Heritage Register preserving its great historical value and mining heritage. A local guide will join the coach for a brief introduction to the town's mining history. Copper from Burra's "Monster Mine" saved South Australia from bankruptcy in the 1840's. It was the largest metal mine in the country employing 1000 people. Cornish and Welsh miners flocked to Burra to work for the South Australian Mining Association, and some set up homes in dugouts hewn out of the banks of the Burra Creek. Small villages which now form Burra North were established - Aberdeen (Scottish), Redruth (Cornish), Llwchyr (Welsh) and Hampton (English). From here we make our way into the South Australian Riverland. We have a fascinating lunch stop today at the *Overland Corner Hotel* – on the Murray River, just to the north of Lake Bonney.



With the arrival of European settlement Overland Corner, located halfway between Adelaide and Mildura, became a major stopover point for drovers taking stock from New South Wales to the Port of Adelaide. From here we head to *Mildura* for our

overnight stop.

Day 8 (BLD): Mildura to Narrandera

Friday 25 October

Our touring today takes us east to *Euston*, where we stop for a close up view of the Murray and then over the vast Hay Plain to *Hay*. The township is on the picturesque Murrumbidgee River. Hay's history is rich with characters and tales of boom and bust - of isolation and

innovation. We make a brief stop at **Shear Outback**, an innovative and exciting interpretative centre devoted to Shearers - those colourful characters of the bush.

We then travel through to *Narrandera* for our overnight stop. Dinner tonight will be at the Narrandera RSL Club opposite the motel.
